

**Information for State Income Tax Purposes**

The ResCap Liquidating Trust (the “Trust”) has recently completed filing income tax returns for the calendar year 2017 in those states in which the Trust has determined that it had a filing obligation, based on the Trust’s property, payroll or other connections with the states. The Trust’s state filing obligation is reduced for the calendar year 2017 due to a reduction in the Trust’s property, payroll and other connections with the states.

The 2017 ResCap Liquidating Trust Beneficiary Tax Worksheets for State Specific Income Tax Purposes for Beneficiaries of Trust Units for the calendar year 2017 reflect the income and deductions that the Trust determined should be allocated to each state in which it filed an income tax return.

Unitholders (“Beneficiaries”) must make their own determination as to which state income tax returns, if any, they are required to file as a result of their ownership of Trust Units or otherwise, and their share of Trust income and deductions, if any, that must be reported on any such state income tax return.
